

2008 Tryout Update

Tryouts are set to begin. This information includes an overview of how tryouts will be administered for Squirts/U10 and above. Details are outlined below. It is critical that we make sure that everyone involved has a clear understanding of how the process works PRIOR to tryouts. This recap includes:

- . Mandatory Parent Meeting
- . Random ID Number Assignments
- . Assessment Due Dates
- . Other Important Dates

A mandatory parent meeting for Bantam, U14, Peewee, and U12 levels will be held during your player's first tryout session. Since the **Squirt/U10** level is new to the entire tryout process, their mandatory parent meeting will be held in October with the time and place to be communicated at a later date. The purpose of the meeting is to explain the tryout process and answer any remaining questions you may have.

Players who know they want to play "C" level hockey and/or do not enjoy the tryout process can elect to not participate in tryouts. They will be placed on a "C" level team. \$50 will be credited to your account. Please contact your level commissioner if you are interested in this option.

All players will be assigned a random ID number before the tryout begins. This random ID number will be used to post all results to the website for PHASE II and PHASE III of the tryouts. **Names will be posted for PHASE I group assignments only.** You must attend the mandatory parent meeting in order to receive your player's random ID number.

All assessments up to a C level must be received by the earlier of October 1st or the first tryout session to be eligible to tryout. The final installment will be determined after teams are formed, and will be due as follows: Bantam, PeeWee, and 12U - November 1st; Squirt, 10U and 14U - November 15th. Volunteer deposit checks must also be on file, or player will not be permitted to participate in tryouts.
