

Substance Policy

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

All Coaches, players, and parents will be expected to maintain the highest standard of conduct and good sportsmanship while representing CCHA at any hockey function.

Gross disrespect to other players, coaches or parents, fighting, swearing to coaches, players, parents or officials, or intent to injure will be cause for automatic suspension and/or disciplinary action by the Board. This also includes the use of drugs, other than those prescribed by a doctor, alcohol, tobacco, or any other illegal substance. Suspension periods may range from one game for the first offense or dismissal from the position, depending on the seriousness of the infraction. The Board of Directors may impose more serious suspensions such as expulsion for repetitive infractions. Expelled personnel will not be allowed to participate on any other CCHA teams for that season. Any infraction of the above from parents, players, or coaches representing other association while participating in CCHA tournaments or games, will result in immediate removal of the offender from the premises, and a report filed to the offending Association's Board.

All District 6, Minnesota Hockey, and USA Hockey disciplinary guidelines will also apply and supersede the minimum disciplinary actions of the CCHA board.
